Located on the campus of The Johns Hopkins University, Homewood is one of the nation's best surviving examples of Federal period architecture. A National Historic Landmark, Homewood is renowned for its elegant proportions, fine workmanship, and extravagant detail. It was built by Charles Carroll Jr with a wedding gift from his father, Charles Carroll of Carrollton, a signer of the Declaration of Independence. Homewood's welcoming interior spaces and brightly colored rooms are filled with objects associated with the Carroll family, including superb examples of Baltimore furniture. After our tour, we will be enjoying lunch at the Inn at the Colonnade.
